

Ecorium Indoor Exhibitions

Five exhibition zones vividly recreate the Earth's representative climate regions, including tropical, desert, Mediterranean, temperate, and polar. By experiencing the living ecosystems through the plants and animals exhibited in each climate zone, visitors can understand the relationship between climate and living organisms.

Desert Biome

Featuring plants and animals adapted to harsh desert environments, including fennec foxes and rattlesnakes, alongside more than 300 species of cacti and succulents.



Mediterranean Biome

More than 300 plant species native to the Mediterranean climate, characterized by dry summers and warm, humid winters, are exhibited here along with five species of amphibians and reptiles and two species of insects.



Temperate Biome

Seven species of amphibians and reptiles, and more than forty species of fish, all native to Korea, and plants from Jeju's Gotjawal forests are exhibited here.



Tropical Biome

The tropical rainforests of Asia, Central and South America, and Africa, where it rains throughout the year, are recreated here, showcasing over 700 species of tropical plants, more than 140 species of fish, and nine species of amphibians and reptiles.



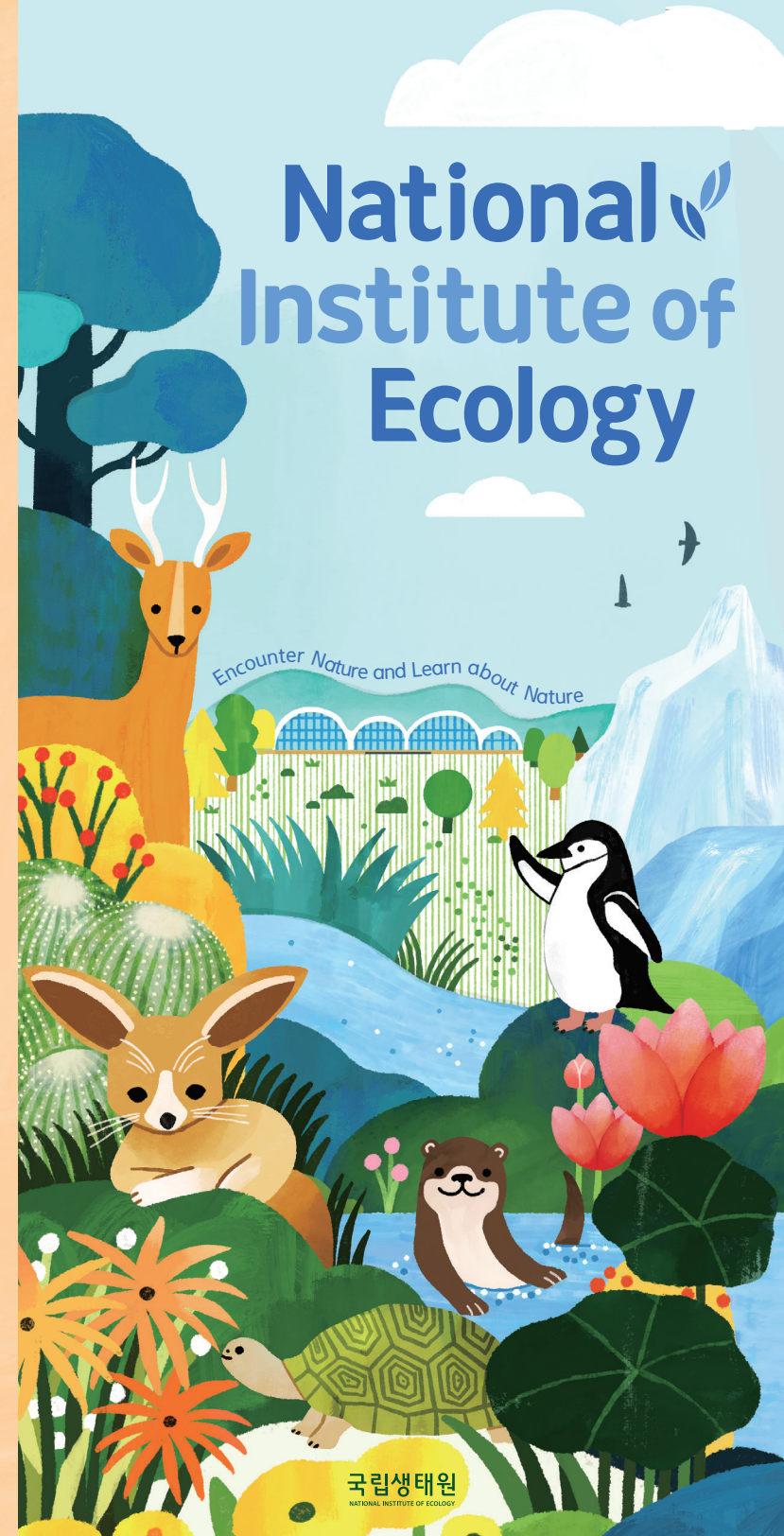
Polar Biome

Explore the frigid Gaema Plateau, the coldest region on the Korean Peninsula, along with polar landscapes such as taiga, tundra, and the King Sejong Station, and encounter chinstrap and gentoo penguins.
